



MANUAL Managing passwords in your browser

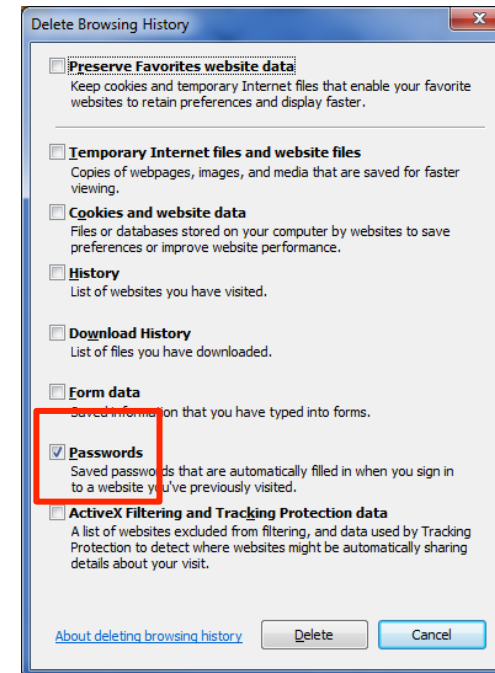
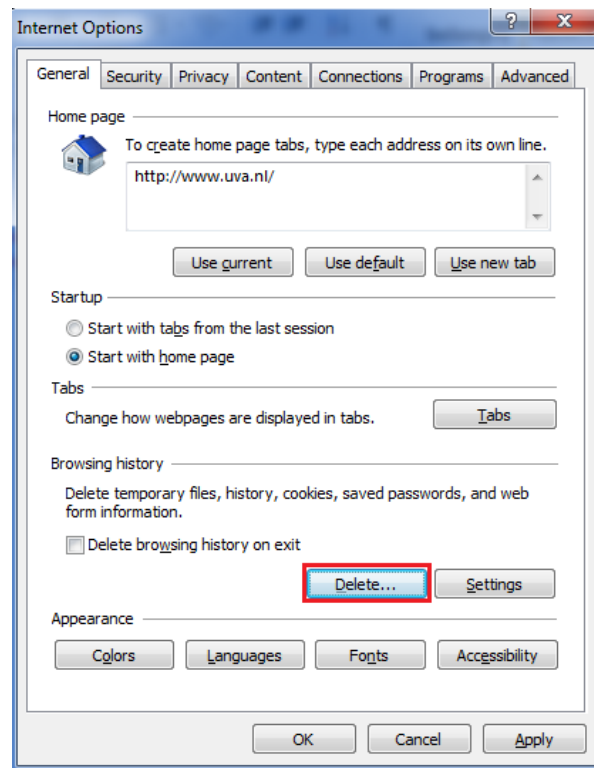
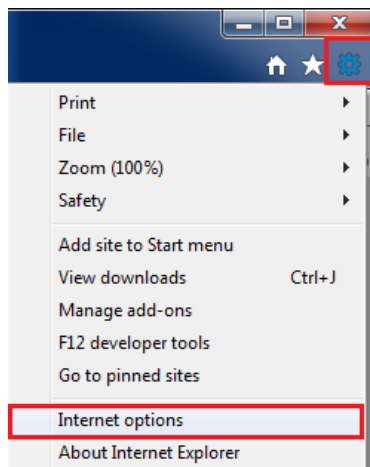
You may have stored your UvA-net ID password in your regular internet browsers. This manual explains how to store your new password in your regular browsers and delete the old password.

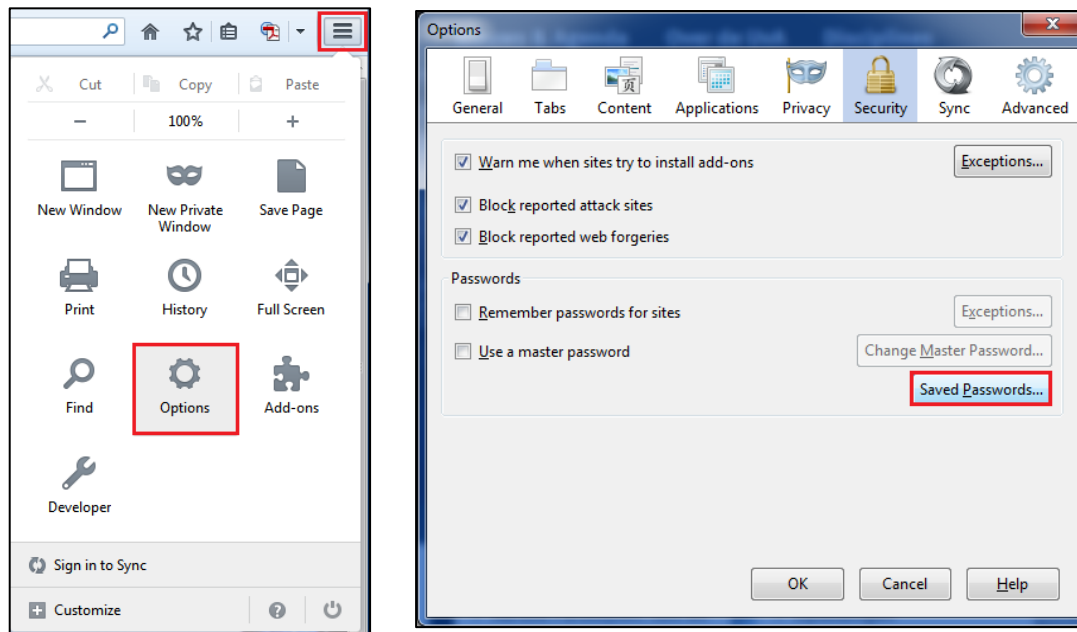
Internet Explorer 10

- Click on the gear icon in the top right-hand section of the Explorer screen and select **Internet options**.
- Select the *General* tab, go to *Browsing History* and click on **Delete**.
- Go to the *Delete Browsing History* window: Select **Passwords**, and remove the check marks from any items you wish to save.
- Click on **Delete**




Mozilla Firefox

- Click on the menu button in the top right-hand section of the screen and select **Options**.
- Select the Security tab and click **Saved Passwords**.
- A new screen will now open, allowing you to delete your UvAnetID passwords.



Chrome

- Click on the menu button in the top right-hand section of the screen and select **Settings**. Chrome will now open a new settings tab.
- Click on **Show advanced settings** in the lower section of the screen. Now select **Manage passwords** under Passwords and forms.
- A new screen will now open, allowing you to delete your UvAnetID passwords.
